
Ref: Your letter dated September 13th, 1961

The following clarification is being provided with regard to the statement contained in Greece's reply to ARQ(61) (item VII, Part II, para 14):

Our statement relates to the air to ground firing range at POTIDEA. This range has the capability of providing, on a rotation basis, firing training facilities for one allied squadron in excess of the requirements of the RAAF.

The above range does not provide any kind of supporting facilities and consequently aircrafts have to return to their parent units after firing. In other words the capability of this range is limited to firing only.

The question of providing supporting facilities (accommodation, maintenance etc.) to allied squadrons at Greek airfields should be examined on a bitateral basis.
