Subject: BERLIN CONTINGENCY PLANNING

.... I have looked through the files which you kindly lent me and I have consulted Mr. Fabiani, who has drawn my attention to the attached dossier which he prepared for you on the occasion of your visit to Berlin in February 1964.

2. This dossier contains much useful information and I suggest that we should draw upon it for the preparation of the note which you envisage sending to the Secretary General. We could give the Secretary General paras. 15 - 22 and para. 27 of Mr. Fabiani's paper, together with brief descriptions of the BERCON and MARCON plans taken from Enclosure I to SGM-479-62, which is in the Red folder on top of your File II. I believe that these, with any necessary editorial amendments, would suffice - at any rate as a first step. I have no strong view upon whether we should include Mr. Fabiani's Annex VII to which he refers in his para. 22(g). I am inclined to think that it would be better to attach it.

3. If you agree, Mr. Fabiani and I will have a suitable minute to the Secretary General prepared for your signature.
